Call this number if you are at an action, to report arrests, to check on a loved one who is in custody, or to report information to us once you are out of custody. This number is activated on request during demonstrations.

**BAY AREA JAIL

Call this number if you have been arrested and are currently inside a local jail. This number is activated on request during demonstrations and when there have been arrests.

**FBI HOTLINE
415-285-1041**

Call this number if you have been contacted by the FBI or another federal agency. Remember, you have the right to remain silent and you have the right to an attorney. Do NOT talk to the FBI or allow them into your home until you have spoken with an attorney.
